Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How do I know if I'm Ready?

A: If you're reading this - you're ready. UDCOC is waiting to help you finish your diploma! Yes, you might have to juggle class and studying with work, kids and other responsibilities. Just remember - almost everyone who has earned a high school equivalency diploma (over 19 million adults) had to go through the same thing. You will have support. No one gets a diploma alone.

Q: How do I get strated?

Q: How do I register for classes?

A: Registering for classes is easy. Once you talk with UDCOC's HiSet® Coordinator, she will guide you through the registration steps.

Q: Do I have to attend classes?

A: Yes... An instructor will teach you three days a week in your small group class. You must be present for the 2.5 hour class. On the fourth day, you will take the practice test for the subject and then schedule the final test.

O: Can I take the actual test online from home?

A: No. The tests can only be taken in person at the UDCOC location. If you see a test on the internet that claims to be a certified high school equivalency test and does not require you to take the test at an official testing center, it is not a legitimate program.

Q: What is the HiSet® test?

A: The HiSet® test is a five subject high school equivalency exam that measures the academic knowledge relative to that of a high school graduate. The exam covers five content areas: Reading, Writing, Math, Social Studies, and Science. After you pass the HiSet®, you will receive your high school equivalency diploma from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

In the event that you do not pass one or more test sections, you'll have the opportunity to retake the HiSet® test. You get two free retests within a year.

Q: How much does this six week class cost?

A: The cost is \$495. A non-refundable deposit of \$125 is due at registration. The balance is due by the first class.
